



## 2008 CONTEST RULES

### **Entry:**

You may enter the contest by purchasing a raffle ticket for the contest between November 23, 2007 and March 8, 2008 or until all tickets are sold. Qualifying for the grand prize will be determined by one random drawing to be held on March 8, 2008.

### **Eligibility:**

Contestants must be legal U.S. residents, 18 years or older and possess a valid driver's license. Employees of the Utica American Heart Association and their immediate families, within 30 days prior to the date the contest begins are ineligible to participate in the contest. Odds of winning depend on the number of entries. A maximum of three thousand seven hundred fifty (3,750) tickets can be sold.

### **Prizes:**

Grand Prize: Winner can choose either the 2 of Hearts or the Ace of Hearts Grand Prize. The 2 of Hearts Grand Prize is two (2) 2008 Honda Fits. The Ace of Hearts Grand Prize is the choice of one (1) 2008 Pontiac Solstice or one (1) 2008 Harley-Davidson FLHX Street Glide with Accessory Package. Only one (1) grand prize will be awarded.
